Description


Portage Park is bordered by the community areas of Jefferson Park and Forest Glen to the north, Dunning and the suburb of Harwood Heights to the west, Irving Park to the east and Belmont-Cragin to the south. A 36-acre namesake park at Irving Park Road and Central Avenue anchors this Northwest Side residential neighborhood. The Six Corners intersection of Irving Park, Milwaukee and Cicero is the site of a historic shopping district dating back to the 1840s. It later became one of Chicago's busiest off-Loop retail areas in the 1940s and '50s. The recently reopened Portage Theater shows classic films in a 1920s-era Art Deco building at the Corners.
































